Tom Gunning, Edwin A. and Betty L. Bergman Distinguished Service Professor, Dept. of Art History, Dept. of Cinema and Media Studies, University of Chicago, will deliver a lecture on Michelle Handelman's four channel video installation *Irma Vep: the last breath* (on view through Jan. 5, 2014) and its relation to Louis Feuillade's 1915 *Les Vampires*, screening daily at the Broad MSU from Sept. 28–Oct. 4, 2013. Gunning works on problems of film style and interpretation, film history, and film culture. His published work has concentrated on early cinema as well as on the culture of modernity from which cinema arose.
